

Multifamily Asset Management Portal (MAMP) Release Notes - Release 11.0

Fannie Mae has implemented Multifamily Asset Management Portal (MAMP) Release 11.0 and new features are now available.

Key Release Highlights:

- MAMP is now compatible with Chrome, Edge and Firefox browsers.
- Multiple enhancements in Borrower Requests (BR) and Completion Repair Agreement (CRA) modules.

Detailed Description of Changes:

Multi-browser Compatibility:

MAMP is now compatible with Chrome, Edge and Firefox browsers.

Enhancements to Borrower Requests (BR) Module:

- Ability to see related Borrower Requests when a new request is initiated at both the Deal and Loan/Property Level.
 - In the BR Create New Request page, a new grid column was added called "Draft Request Exists". This enhancement will help users eliminate the duplicate request creation.
 - When a user attempts to create a borrower request with the same "Master Request Type", "Request Type" & "Request Subtype" as an existing one, then the grid column "Draft Request Exists" will populate with a hyperlink the user can click to see the existing request.



- Ability to upload multiple documents to a Borrower Request at one time
 - New button on the Request Detail tab called "Select Multiple Attachments"
 - After a user selects files to upload, a grid appears allowing them to enter a file description for each. If "Other" is selected, then an "Other File Description" is required.




Enhancements to Completion Repair Agreement (CRA) Module:

- For "non-Green loan" requests:
 - Modified the due date extension process (i.e. new due date < 2 years from the original due date) to remove the automatic creation of borrower requests, upon extension.
 - Modified the due date extension messaging to show the new request type.



- For "Green loan" requests:
 - Updated the due date extension messaging to instruct users that "All Green Program CRA extensions, whether delegated or nondelegated, must be entered in DUS Property Monitor."
