Sponsor-Initiated Affordability (SIA)

Target: Multifamily Affordable

Minimum Threshold	20% of units restricted to tenants earning up to 80% of Area Median Income (AMI)
Restrictions	Income and rent restrictions in place for the life of the Mortgage Loan
Compliance Monitoring	Third-party verification of annual rent and tenant income
Required Loan Documents	 Sponsor-Initiated Affordability Agreement (Form 6490); Modifications to Loan Agreement (Sponsor-Initiated Affordability) (Form 6271); and Payment Guaranty (Pricing Incentive Recapture) (Form 6020.PIR)

Sponsor-Dedicated Workforce (SDW) Housing

Target: Conventional 20% of units restricted to tenants Minimum earning up to 80% of AMI or, in **Threshold** certain metros, up to 100% – 120% of AMI Rent restrictions in place for the Restrictions life of the Mortgage Loan Annual Servicer review; the Borrower must annually submit rent rolls to the Servicer and a Compliance certification of compliance with Monitoring the SDW-rent restrictions via the Supplemental Annual Loan Agreement Certification (Form 6620.Supplemental.SDW) • Modifications to Loan Agreement (Sponsor-Dedicated Workforce Housing (Form 6271. **Required Loan** SDW); and **Documents** Modifications to Security Agreement (Sponsor-Dedicated Workforce Housing (Form 6325)
